Judge Mark J. Moore Receives Endorsements from Labor and City Officials for His Court of Common Pleas Judicial Election

Support Continues to Grow in Philadelphia for the Philadelphia Bar Association's Highly Recommended Candidate

Philadelphia, PA— April 21, 2021 — Court of Common Pleas Judicial candidate, Judge Mark J. Moore announced today that, to date, he has been endorsed by seven city and labor organizations from Philadelphia. An exceptional assemblage of state legislators, elected officials and political organizations have also backed his Judicial candidacy for the Philadelphia Court of Common Pleas.

The campaign's latest endorsement is from Rebecca Rhyhart, City Controller. She said, "Judge Moore is a passionate public servant and proud advocate for all Philadelphians. Judge Moore has also been endorsed by the AFL-CIO. In addition to this broad and growing political and labor support, Judge Moore is "[Highly Recommended](#)" by the Philadelphia Bar Association.

After more than 20 years in the courtroom as an experienced civil and criminal trial attorney, Judge Moore had the honor of being appointed to the Philadelphia Court of Common Pleas, in July 2020, by Governor Tom Wolf. Judge Moore sits in the Criminal Trial Division and presides over motions and guilty pleas on a daily basis. He is running for election this May 18th to retain a full ten-year term. His ballot number is 23.
